



**PAIDEIA – FOURTH UNIVALI INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR ON SCIENTIFIC
INITIATION
23 to 27 of September of 2024
EDITAL FOR SUBMISSION, PRESENTATION AND PUBLICATION OF
ACADEMIC SUMMARIES**

The Director of Education of the Vice-Rector of Graduation and Institutional Development, the Director of the School of Legal and Social Sciences and the Paideia Research and Extension Group announce the rules for submission, presentation and publication of scientific production in PAIDEIA - Third UNIVALI International Seminar on Scientific Initiation, event that will take place, from **September 23 to 27, 2023**.

This Edital is for the submission, presentation and publication of scientific production is directed to students and professors of any graduation course, from national and foreign institutions.

Chapter I - Submission Date and Results

Article 1. The date for submission of academic summaries will be **April 08, 2024 to August 19, 2024** at 23 hours and 59 minutes (11:59 p.m.).

Article 2. The list of approved academic summaries will be published on the event's website (www.univalipaideiasic.com.br) until **September 4th, 2024**, being the responsibility of the authors to consult the results of the selection.

Chapter II - Submission Procedure

Article 3. The registration of academic summaries must be done entirely online, **by ELIS system** or other that UNIVALI suggests.

Sole paragraph. At the time of submission of the academic summaries, the author must select the option of presentation of the work, whether it will be made in on campus or virtual (online) mode.

Article 4. Regarding registration fees for abstract authors:

- For UNIVALI graduation students - R\$ 20,00 (twenty reais);
- For students from other national institutions - R\$ 30,00 (thirty reais);
- For students from foreign institutions - R\$ 50,00 (fifty reais).

Sole paragraph. All authors (except the advisors) must pay for the submission of the paper. Failure to pay the registration fee results in not receiving the presentation certificate and in not publishing the academic summaries in the event annals.



Article 5. The academic summaries must be submitted as follows: an attachment with the version in **WORD** format **with identification of the author(s)** and an attachment with the version in **PDF** format **without identification of the author(s)** that will be used for evaluation.

Article 6. Each author may submit up to three expanded abstracts, admitting abstracts with a maximum of three authors, one of them being the advisor. The advisor must be a professor with a master or doctoral degree. For the other authors (not advisors) there is no requirement of title.

Paragraph 1. If the expanded abstract has been prepared by more than one author, only one of the authors must submit the paper, adding the other authors in the ELIS registration system.

Paragraph 2. For this call for papers, an graduation student is considered an author.

Paragraph 3. Advisors may participate in an unlimited number of works.

Paragraph 4. Undergraduate students and/or postgraduate students (specialization, masters and doctorate) can participate as co-authors of papers, however, only expanded abstracts containing at least one undergraduate student as an author will be evaluated.

Article 7. After submission of the extended abstract, the substitution, correction or modification of any nature will not be allowed.

Article 8. By submitting the abstract, the author(s) is (are) assigning the rights to the contents for an indefinite period, as well as the rights to exhibit, publish, reproduce, store and/or otherwise use them, agreeing to this condition expressly and irrevocably, since now and by right, free of charge and without any remuneration, burden or charge, in favor of this organization.

Chapter IV - Major Areas of Scientific Production

Art. 9. Expanded abstracts can be developed in all areas of knowledge.

Chapter V - The Timetable

Art. 10. The calendar obeys the following schedule:

Until 04/09/2024	Announcement of the summaries approved for presentation in each area
23 to 27/09/2024 Morning, afternoon and evening periods.	Presentation of works

Chapter VI - Rules for writing the extended abstract

Art. 11. The academic summaries must have a minimum of 3 (three) and a maximum of 5 (five) pages.



Sole paragraph. The abstract must be unpublished, that is, it must not have been published in any other national or foreign journal, and it must not be under evaluation process for publication in another journal during this evaluation process.

Art. 12. Nature and basic structuring elements of the abstracts:

- a) The summaries must be unpublished, written in Portuguese, English, Spanish or Italian and must follow the guidelines: title in the language in which the summaries were written, title in another language authorized by this Edital, name of the authors and advisor, introduction, indication of three keywords, research problem, objective, research method, results achieved and references;
 - b) These topics should be clearly highlighted/specified in bold throughout the text;
 - c) The identification of the author(s), in a footnote, should include the title, institution to which the author is affiliated, country and e-mail address for correspondence;
- Note:** The identification of the authors must appear ONLY in the Word file.
- d) For the submission of the summaries, observe the model in the Attachment of this Edital.

Article 13. The methodological rules for the structure of expanded abstracts are as follows:

- a) font Arial, size 12;
- b) space between lines: 1,5;
- c) 3 cm margins;
- d) sheet: A4;
- e) paragraph – back and front spacing: 0 points;
- f) justified alignment;
- g) paragraph entry of 1,25 cm.

Article 14. Quotations and notes must be prepared according to the following requirements:

- a) Short textual quotations (up to three lines) should be inserted in the text, between quotation marks and without italics;
- b) Long textual quotations (more than three lines) should come in an independent paragraph, indented from the left margin 4.0 cm, Arial 10 font, single spaced and without quotation marks;
- c) The indication of works cited must be done in a footnote and not in an endnote (indicate the complete reference of the work in the first citation and, after that, highlight only the author's name, the title of the work and the page number);
- d) Abstracts that use the author-date mode or expressions such as Op.Cit., Idem and Ibidem will not be accepted;
- e) The names of works should be in bold italics.

Article 15. The signed academic summaries are the sole and exclusive responsibility of the authors. The content of the signed abstracts does not reflect the opinion of the organizers and coordinators of the Event.

Chapter VII - Evaluation

Article 16. The minimum grade for approval will be 7,0 (seven points). The grades will be ranked by criteria met from 0 (zero) to 10 (ten).



Sole Paragraph. The evaluators will take into consideration in the analysis of the abstracts, in addition to the rules already adopted in this edital, the originality of the research, the coherence between problem, objective and methodology, the quality of the writing and the depth of the bibliographical references.

Chapter VIII - Presentation of the Abstracts

Article 17 - Only one author can present the approved summary, with a limit of 7 (seven) minutes for presentation. The presentation must be made in one of the languages allowed by this edital (Portuguese, English, Spanish or Italian).

Paragraph 1. The presentation may be made in person or virtual (online) models. For those presenting in the virtual model, it is mandatory to have access to a webcam and a properly functioning microphone. Those who are interested can contact the event coordination beforehand to test them.

Paragraph 2. It should be noted that the presentation must be made by an undergraduate author.

Article 18. The author should organize himself to be present and participate in the presentation of all the papers, and not only of his own expanded abstract, and should thus honor the other presentations.

Article 19. All authors will receive a certificate of expanded abstract presentation.

Chapter X - Rules for the Publication of the Annals

Art. 20 - All approved summaries presented in the event will be published in e-book format, with ISSN. **The authors of the papers agree with the assignment of their copyrights for publication.**

Chapter XI – Of the abstracts selected for publication in the Journal

Art. 21 - Eventually, some expanded abstracts will be selected for subsequent development of a scientific article and, consequently, publication in Paideia's scientific journal.

Chapter XII - Final Provisions

Art. 22 - Abstracts will be disqualified and excluded from the Seminar if it is verified, in any of its stages, that they do not comply with the provisions contained in this announcement. Or that does not follow the ethical standards of publication.

Art. 23 - Cases of omission will be settled by the event organization.
